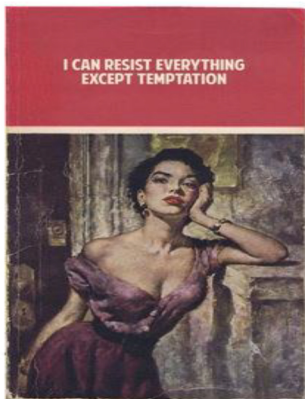
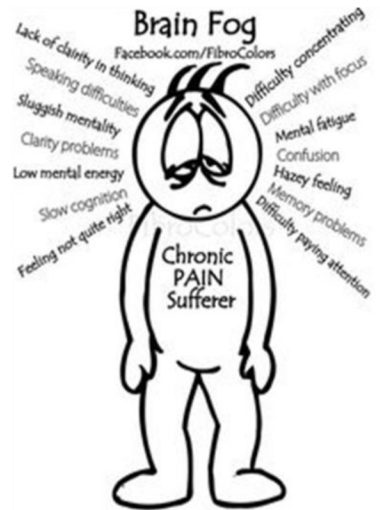


Have you been affected by Hepatitis C, would you like an opportunity to show how Hepatitis C has affected your life?
